Announcing Our Lag Trip to Gudbrandsdal June, 2005

Enclosed with this newsletter is the brochure describing a marvelous cultural tour to the land of our ancestors. This is an opportunity as no other tour will concentrate on the culture, sights and people of Gudbrandsdal as we do in this plan. Other tours will provide a taste of the area but none will provide the opportunity to really understand all the communities of Gudbrandsdal. We will visit unique farms, see the art and craft talents from the area, learn about the people of yesterday and today and see the beautiful scenery of this rich valley of valleys in Norway. Brekke Tours has worked long and hard to put this trip together.

A special committee from our lag consisting of Carmen Moe, Betty Strand, Marilyn Sorensen and Jim Olson has worked diligently with Brekke Tours. Initially we established a list of what we wanted to see, discussed it with some friends from Norway and then worked on the feasibility of seeing everything we wished to include. After talking with many members, we realized that the cultural tour and genealogy research should not be combined. Therefore there are several options to consider. They may all be selected by a lag member or only one part of it may be chosen. Options include a Genealogy Seminar from June 12-20, 2005, Cultural Tour from June 19-July 2, 2005, a personal tour of Norway either before or after the Cultural Tour and an opportunity to visit with relatives from July 2 to July 10, 2005. This allows for participant flexibility.

Note there is a land price only if you wish to make your own travel arrangements to Norway. Air fare is included in the main price for the cultural tour and all the options are land prices.

Look for descriptions in the brochure. Cost is noted at the end of each portion and includes all the items covered. It is an exciting tour and we hope many will be able to join us. NOTE THERE IS A FEBRUARY 1, 2005 CUT OFF DATE AND APPLICATIONS ARE TAKEN ON A FIRST COME FIRST SERVED BASIS.

Genealogy Seminar—June 12-20. Seminar is being developed by Gudbrandsdal genealogists in cooperation with the lag. Persons who sign up for the seminar should send a pedigree chart to Marilyn Sorensen at 4468 Arden View Court, St. Paul, MN 55112. Purpose is to do initial family research before the tour and combine it with help the lag can give each participant. When we have completed our work, a copy will be sent to the committee in Norway.

<u>Cultural Tour—June 19-July 2</u>. This tour is combined with many events being planned by the Ringebu community to celebrate 100 years of the Norwegian Constitution.

Tour Norway—July 2-10 or June 12-20. Some participants may wish to see other parts of Norway in addition to Gudbrandsdal. This option provides the opportunity.

<u>Visit relatives—July 2-10.</u> Many of our members know relatives in Norway. If you wish to visit them, this is an add on that will provide the time to do so.

Day 1 - Sunday, June 19 - MPLS/ST.PAUL-OSLO

Depart Mpls/St.Paul on your Icelandair flight or request space from your home city upon registration.

Day 2 - Monday, June 20 - OSLO-HAMAR

Arrive Gardermoen Airport Oslo. Enroute to Hamar, visit Eidsvoll, site of the signing of Norway's Constitution on May 17, 1814. Dinner and overnight at the Scandic Hotel Hamar.

Day 3 - Tuesday, June 21 - HAMAR

Breakfast. Morning visit to the home of the world famous soprano, Kirsten Flagstad. View the famous Olympic Ice Hall with its unique design constructed for the 1994 Winter Olympics. Visit the Emigrant Museum and the church which was moved from Houston, MN. Lunch with lecture by the museum's director, Knut Djupedal. Continue to the Glass Cathedral. Opened in 1988 with its special construction of glass and steel, it is an architectural and technological masterpiece. The building's primary function is to protect the cathedral ruins, which is one of Norway's foremost cultural landmarks from the Middle Ages. Drive to Gjøvik. At 5:30pm depart on the world's oldest paddlesteamer, *Skibladner*, which has been plying the waters of Norway's largest lake, Lake Mjøsa, since 1856. Dinner on board includes Skibladner's traditional salmon with strawberries and cream for dessert. Arrive Hamar at 6:45pm. Transfer to hotel. Overnight at Scandic Hotel Hamar.

Day 4 - Wednesday, June 22 - HAMAR-LILLEHAMMER-ØYER

Breakfast. Drive to Lillehammer, site of the 1994 Winter Olympics. Tour the open-air museum at Maihaugen, with its collection of buildings from the Gudbrandsdal Valley. Time on own for explorations. Prior to departure, see the Lillehammer Church and view the Olympic sites. Proceed to Quality Hafjell Hotel in Øyer for dinner and overnight.

Day 5 - Thursday, June 23 - EXCURSION to GAUSDAL/ESPEDAL

Breakfast. Drive to Gausdal. Visit Aulestad, the home of Norway's national poet, Bjørnstjerne Bjørnson. Crossing the Segalstad Bridge we arrive in the agricultural district of East Gausdal. Tour the Østre Gausdal Church. Travel the Peer Gynt Road. The legendary Per Gynt is said to have roamed this area and inspired the poet and dramatic Henrik Ibsen to write his famous play, *Peer Gynt*. At Ruten we reach an altitude of 5000 ft. and enjoy views of the Jotunheim and Rondane mountain ranges. Continue to Espedalen. Drive south through the Espedal Valley with its rich flora and fauna and beautiful lakes. During the 17th century there were copper works in the valley and from 1846 to 1878 nickel was also mined. Near the Espedal Lake lies the Espedal Mt. Church. Tour the church with its unusual graveyard. Towards Gausdal we find Helvete (Hell) which is the name given to the largest potholes in Europe, many of them more than 160 ft deep and 65 ft wide. Visits will be made at the Svartsum and Vestre Gausdal Church. Stop at the home of a clairvoyant, Knut Rasmussen Nordgaarden ("Wise Knut", 1782-1876), who was famous throughout the country for his healing powers and his ability to find the lost. Return to Quality Hotel Hafjell for dinner and overnight.

Day 6 - Friday, June 24 - ØYER-RINGEBU

Breakfast. Learn about the local office governing the municipality (kommune) of Øyer (Tretten is now under Øyer kommune), as well as the services provided by the *kommune*. (Visit to local office pending.) Tour the churches in Øyer and Tretten. Continue to Gudbrandsgård Hotel, our home for the next three nights. The hotel, at an altitude of 2443 ft., is situated close to the middle station on the Olympic Downhill Arena at Kvitfjell, one of the most varied and challenging alpine arenas in Europe. *Welcome banquet and opening of the Ringebu Emigration Festival.*

Day 7 - Saturday, June 25 - RINGEBU

Breakfast. Participate in Ringebu Days. Dinner and cultural evening at Dalegudbrands Farm with folk music and local culture. Overnight at Gudbrandsgård Hotel.

Day 8 - Sunday, June 26 - EXCURSION in RINGEBU & NORD FRON

Breakfast. Participate in Ringebu Days. Church service in Ringebu Stave Church, one of the largest of the remaining stave churches in Norway from 1220 and tour of church. Coffee at Ringebusamlingene/Prestegarden. Afternoon excursion to Nord Fron with visits to Hundorp and Vinstra. In Hundorp visit the Sør Fron Church referred to as Gudbrandsdal's Cathedral. No other district in Gudbrandsdal has had as many churches as Sør Fron. Continue to Vinstra. Visit the Sødorp Church. At the Sødorp Chapel we view the Peer Gynt Memorial, in memory of the legendary Per Gynt who lent his name and character to Henrik Ibsen's play "Peer Gynt". Meet the historical Per and the literary Peer upon viewing the Peer Gynt collection at the Peer Gynt stugu from 1743, a house from the farm where historical Per lived. Dinner (middag) at 4:00pm at Sygard Grytting in Harpefoss. Return to Ringebu for a 7:00pm International church concert in the stave church. Overnight at Gudbrandsgård Hotel.

Day 9 - Monday, June 27 - RINGEBU-VENABU

Breakfast. Visit a "Seter" (mountain farm) in Fåvangfjellet. Introduction to cheesemaking. Samples available. Dinner and overnight at Venabu Mt. Hotel. Concert in the Venabygd's Mt. Chapel.

Day 10 - Tuesday, June 28 - VENABU-FOLLDAL-HJERKJENN-DOMBÅS-LESJA-OTTA

Breakfast. Cross the Venabygd Mts. between the valley of Gudbrandsdal and Østerdal and encircle Rondane, Norway's first national park, with its spectacular mountain range protecting herds of wild reindeer. Travel through Folldal, a mountain mining community, as well as Hjerkjenn, and Dombås. Continue to Lesja. Tour the Lesja Church, richly decorated with carved tableaux depicting Bible stories. Visit the Lesja Bygdetun, an open-air museum with a collection of 11 houses which illustrates architecture, way of life and conditions in olden times. Dinner at the museum. Drive to Otta. Proceed to Rondeslottet, our mountain hotel.

Day 11 - Wednesday, June 29 - EXCURSION to SEL and DOVRE

Breakfast. Morning free to enjoy the mountain scenery and fresh clean air. Afternoon excursion to Sel. View Sel Church (no entrance), a log church built in 1742. At Nord Sel Church (no entrance) we find a memorial and the graves of British soldiers who fell in this area in 1940. Arrive at Jørundgård, a reconstructed medieval farm, setting of the main work of Nobel prize winner Sigrid Undset's *Kristin Lavransdatter*. The trilogy, now translated into more than 70 languages is the most widely-read novel of the 20th century. Continue to Dovre. Following a tour of the Dovre Church, a cross-shaped church built in 1736 from hand-shaped jointed timbers, we visit Budsjord, a protected farm. One of the 17 buildings is believed to date back to the 1400's when this was a farm belonging to the bishop. The other structures were built in the 17th and 18th centuries. Dinner at the farm. Return to hotel for overnight.

Day 12 - Thursday, June 30 - EXCURSION to LOM and SKJÅK

Breakfast. Enroute to Lom and Skjåk visit the Jutulheimen Museum, west of Vågåmo, which contains buildings from farms in Vågå. Following a visit to Vågå Church, drive to Lom and tour the Lom Stave Church. Proceed to the Norsk Fjell Museum (Mountain Museum) which represents all aspects of the Norwegian mountain landscape and shows the diversity of interaction between mountains and men. Tour the Lom Bygda Museum, thought to be one of the most beautiful museums in the country. In Skjåk visit the Nordberg Church. Upon returning, drive via Heidal and along the famous Sjoa River, one of Northern Europe's finest and most popular white-water rafting rivers to Sjoa. Dinner at hotel.

Day 13 - Friday, July 1 - OTTA-KVAM-RINGEBU-FEFOR/VINSTRA

Breakfast. Morning at leisure. South of Otta we see the Kringen Monument and learn about the Battle of Kringen. Drive to Kvam. View Sinclair's grave commemorating George Sinclair, the leader of the Scottish mercenaries who were on their way to Sweden in 1612 to assist the Swedes in their war against Denmark/Norway. The Scots were stopped at the Battle of Kringen and George Sinclair fell. See the English War Memorial at Kvam Church. Lunch on own at Sinclair's Restaurant. At 1:00pm tour the Gudbrandsdal War Museum offering an insight into the events which took place in Gudbrandsdal during WWII. At 2:30pm depart for Fefor Mountain Hotel. Check-in and early dinner at 4:00pm. Depart for 7:00pm performance of the play "Jehans Nordbu". Return to Fefor Mountain Hotel for overnight.

Day 14 - Saturday, July 2 - VINSTRA-OSLO AIRPORT

Breakfast. Time at disposal for additional explorations. Proceed to Radisson SAS Airport Hotel Oslo for dinner and overnight.

Day 15 - Sunday, July 3 - OSLO AIRPORT-USA

Breakfast. Proceed to airport for return flight. Longer stays may be requested upon registration for an additional charge of \$30.

Depart Mpls/St.Paul on your transatlantic flight or request space from your home city upon registration. Note: Bergen is served by Northwest/KLM and Scandinavian Airlines, not Icelandair. As the tour package is based on Icelandair to Oslo, please inquire about domestic airfare from Oslo to Bergen.

Day 2 - Thursday, June 16 - Bergen

Arrive Bergen. Independent transfer to Clarion Hotel in city center. Balance of day free to relax and adjust to time change. Dinner on own.

Day 3 - Friday, June 17 - Bergen-Voss

Morning sightseeing tour of Norway's second largest city begins at 10:00am (in front of Tourist Information Office) and includes a visit to Troldhaugen, home of Norway's renowned musician, the late Edvard Grieg. Afternoon train departure to the popular summer and winter resort community of Voss. Depart Bergen at 3:58pm. Arrive Voss at 5:09pm. Dinner and overnight at the charming Fleischer's Hotel.

Day 4 - Saturday, June 18 - Voss-Flåm-Oslo

GENERAL INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS

RESERVATIONS & PAYMENT

To make reservations, complete application form and send deposit of \$300 per person to address shown on application form. The final balance is due 60 days prior to departure. Early departures and/or extended stays are subject to availability, must be requested upon registration, and entail a surcharge of \$30, plus weekend surcharge of \$30 per direction, if applicable. For reservations or final payment made within 21 days prior to departure, there is a \$25 per reservation handling/express fee. Checks, Money Orders, VISA and MasterCard are accepted as forms of payment. In case of billing error, we reserve the right to re-invoice with correct pricing.

LAND COSTS

The tour price is based on a minimum of 35 persons. The trip will be feasible with fewer than 35, but the price may increase. All rates are based on tariffs in effect at the time the tour was planned and are subject to increase in the event of currency fluctuation.

CANCELLATIONS

The following per person cancellation fee applies: More than 60 days prior to departure: \$200; 60-45 days: \$500; 44-7 days: \$2000; less than 7 days: nonrefundable. Cancellations must be in writing.

CHANGES

Once deposit has been received, each subsequent change will be subject to a change fee of \$30 per person, only if we can accept the change and travel documents have not been issued. If documents are issued and we can accept the change there will be a reissue fee of \$50 per person plus any fees assessed by air/land supplier/s.

AIR TRANSPORTATION

Tour price is based on scheduled transportation in economy class with nonrefundable airfare on our preferred airline partners. Client preference for carriers may incur additional charges. The tour package price reflects airfare currently in effect, and is subject to change. The airlines concerned are not held responsible for any act or event during the time the passengers are not on board their planes or conveyances. The passenger's contract in use by the airline, when issued, shall constitute the sole contract between the airline and the passenger. First-class private motor coach. Other transportation and/or accommodations as indicated.

SPECIAL REQUESTS

Special hotel and flight requests, such as "double bed", "room near elevator", "room on lower floor", "meals", "seating on aircraft", etc. should be submitted in writing with final payment, 60 days prior to departure. Please be advised, however, that such requests are outside of our control and therefore cannot be guaranteed.

SERVICE CHARGES, TIPS AND TAXES

All service charges and taxes at hotels are included, so extra tipping will not be necessary. Gratuities to tour director/guide and driver are customarily left to the discretion of the tour member and are therefore not included in the tour cost.

MEALS

Breakfast, lunch and dinner as specified in the itinerary. Special requests for meals should be submitted in writing with final payment, 60 days prior to departure. Special meal requests cannot be guaranteed.

HOTELS

Accommodations in rooms with private facilities at hotels specified or similar. Brekke Tours reserves the right to substitute hotels with others of equal or better quality. Rooms in Scandinavian hotels may have twin, double, or day beds. As Scandinavian hotels generally have small rooms, we advise against requesting triple rooms. Triple rooms are available on request only and no discount applies. A limited number of single rooms are available at the supplementary cost shown. Single rooms are generally inferior to double rooms in size and location. All rooms are assigned by the hotel management upon arrival. Please note that throughout Europe it is standard policy that hotel rooms are not available for check-in before 2:00pm. Requests for special room assignments should be submitted in writing with final payment, 60 days prior to departure. Special room equests cannot be guaranteed. Please be advised that not all hotels in Scandinavia are air-conditioned.

SMOKING

Smoking is not permitted on airplanes nor motor coaches.

LUGGAGE

Airline regulations regarding baggage allowances on board international and inter-European flights are subject to change, so check with your airline before departure. Current restrictions for most international airline flights are two checked pieces with combined overall dimension (length+width+height) not to exceed 108 inches and no single piece may exceed 62 inches. In addition, a carry-on bag is permitted, not to exceed 45 inches. On the land portion, due to limited motor coach capacity, we allow only 1 suitcase and 1 carry-on per person. Porterage for one normal size suitcase is provided (except at airports, where international security regulations require you to be responsible for your own luggage). Baggage is carried at owner's risk and baggage insurance is recommended.

INSURANCE

The client is urged to protect his/her investment with travel insurance. Request brochure or visit www.brekketours.com for further information. Brekke Tours is not responsible for loss, damage or theft of luggage or personal belongings, or for personal injury, accident or illness.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

With full payment, documents are normally sent 14-21 days prior to departure and should arrive within 6 business days. If you request documents earlier, and if it is possible to accommodate you, there is a \$25 per reservation handling/express fee. Each passenger must be in possession of a valid passport. A visa is **not** required for Scandinavia or Western Europe for stays of less than 3 months.
